

Quick Reminders

Snow Days: With snow in the forecast, please remember that our snow day policy is to follow the decision made by the Salem-Keizer School District. If they are closed, we are closed as well. If there is a 2-hour delay, we will cancel our preschool and prekindergarten morning classes. Other classes will begin at 11 a.m. Childcare will do the same, but please call ahead to be sure a staff member is at school to receive your child.

Drop Off: Kindly remember that classes start at 9 a.m. If you arrive after that time, please do not interrupt class by knocking on the classroom door. Instead, check in your child at the office and the office staff will take them to class. Thank you!

Immunization: RCS follows Oregon State Law with regards to immunizations. If your child is not up-to-date on immunizations, and you have not met the requirements for an exemption, your child will not be permitted to attend school effective February 19.
